

----- Sewer Interceptor Project Update -----

Please see the attached information and detour route regarding the City of Genoa's sewer interceptor project that involves closing certain streets.

Updates will be provided to those individuals and agencies that may be affected by the street closing.

Due to the weather, Brown Street - From Route 72 to First Street is rescheduled to be closed on Monday - May 17, 2010. We anticipate this portion of the road to be closed for 5 days to allow the contractor enough time to install the sewer pipe and manhole structure.

Brown Street through traffic will be detoured on Route 72 to N. Sycamore Street.

A notice will be given when the road is actually closed for vehicle traffic.

----- Illinois Department of Transportation Highway Project Update -----

The resurfacing work on Route 72 is scheduled to start Tuesday - May 18, 2010. The work is estimated to take 3 – 4 weeks depending on the weather and should be completed before Genoa Days. The project will start at W. Main Street and end just west of Stiles Street where the concrete portion of the road begins.

When work starts, there will not be any detours setup for the project. They intend to work on one side of the road at a time and direct traffic around the work zone using flagmen.

Sewer Construction Project

The work to install the City's sewer interceptor has started. The project involves excavating and installing sewer pipe along the south side of the railroad tracks that run through the center of town. The work has begun just west of W. Main Street and will end just east of Prairie Street.

The work will require closing the following streets on separate occasions for a minimum of three days depending on the difficulty of work. **Only one street will be closed at a time**, allowing motorists to use the other three streets that provide rail crossings to get to their destination.

1.) W. Main Street – From Route 72 to First Street

2.) Washington Street – From Route 72 to First Street

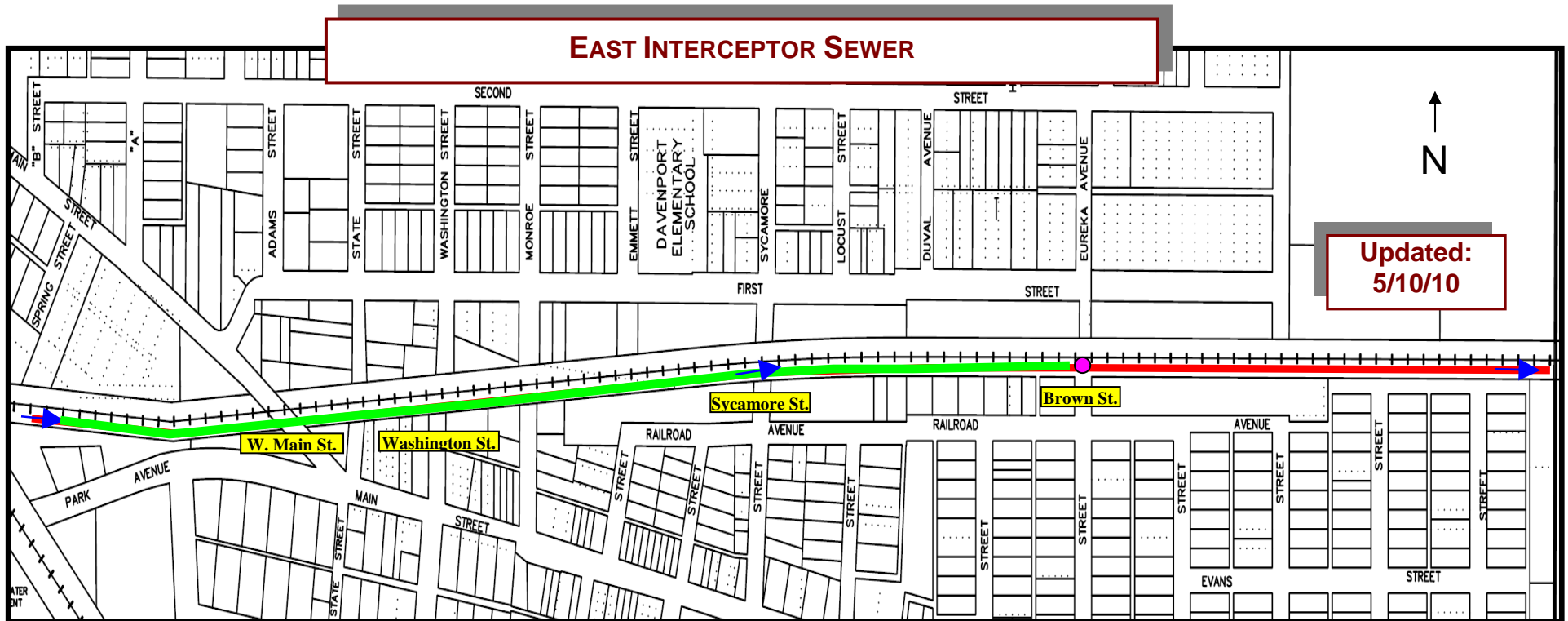
3.) Sycamore Street – From Railroad Avenue to First Street

4.) Brown Street – Railroad Avenue to First Street

The City will post yellow signs at different locations prior to the actual street closing to inform motorists that the subject street will be closed during a predetermined timeframe. When the street is closed, detour signs will be posted. The dates for the street closures may change depending on the progress of work or weather conditions.
