UPDATE MAY 2010

COMPLETED PROJECTS-

Route 23 and Pearson Drive Intersection – The major intersection improvement project is complete.

West Main Street (Genoa Road) from Route 72 to City Limits past Middle School – The major resurfacing is complete.

Spring Street south of West Main Street – The resurfacing project is complete.

Oak Street south of West Main Street– The resurfacing project is complete.

“A” Street from West Main Street to Second Street – The resurfacing project is complete.

“B” Street from West Main Street to Second Street – The resurfacing project is complete.

East First Street from Sycamore Street to Eureka Street – The major resurfacing project is complete.

NEW PROJECTS-

Main Street (Route 72) from Illinois 23 (Sycamore Road) to West Main Street (Genoa Road) – roto-mill grinding and resurfacing with new asphalt overlay, along with sidewalk ramping is under construction beginning in late April and is expected to be completed in June 2010.

Second Street from Emmett Street to “B” Street at Middle School – Resurfacing - IDOT plan approval has been received. Ready for bid, as soon as State funds are released.

North Monroe Street from Second Street to First Street – Resurfacing - IDOT plan approval has been received. Ready for bid, as soon as State funds are released.

Washington Street from Second Street to First Street – Resurfacing - IDOT plan approval has been received. Ready for bid, as soon as State funds are released.

All of Robinson Street – Engineering plans are being reviewed by Public Works staff for completion in bid ready form.

North Locust, between Main and Railroad - Engineering plans are being reviewed by Public Works staff for completion in bid ready form.

North Locust north of Second Street to the north end of the asphalt section - Engineering plans are being reviewed by Public Works staff for completion in bid ready form.

North Stott Street - Engineering plans are being reviewed by Public Works staff for completion in bid ready form.

All of Stiles Street - Engineering plans are being reviewed by Public Works staff for completion in bid ready form.

Streets listed below are planned for resurfacing in the City’s Accelerated Street Resurfacing Program planned over the next few years, and will be undergoing engineering plans for the approval of IDOT required under the Motor Fuel Tax law:

South Genoa Street – from Main Street to Hill Street since it appears from preliminary engineering information has indicated that it is possible to overlay the existing concrete street surface with a new surface.

Jackson Street, from Jackson Court to Emmett Street

South Emmett Street, from Jackson to Hill Street;

all of Hickory Drive

South Washington Street – Resurfacing from Main Street to Hill Street – has been approved by IDOT for Federal grant funding under the STP-U program as part of the 2012 program.
