

PLEASE REMEMBER.....

PARKING ON CITY STREETS IS PROHIBITED FROM 2 AM TO 5 AM FROM DECEMBER 1 THROUGH MARCH 31

Although many Cities and Villages prohibit parking on City Streets between 2 AM to 5 AM all year round, Genoa has minimized the needed restrictions by only prohibiting parking on City Streets from 2 AM to 5 AM from December 1st through March 31st

These restrictions are necessary in order to safely and efficiently conduct snow removal operations. Parked cars represent dangerous hazards to plow drivers, particularly in blowing and drifting conditions at night. Vehicles parked on the street get plowed in and when dug out snow is dumped back onto the plowed streets, not only costing taxpayers extra cost for cleanup, but even more importantly this can create an unexpected hazard for motorists.

Areas blocked by parked cars prevent pushing snow back onto parkways resulting in narrowed streets hampering traffic flow and this also prevents the creation of space for snow from the next storm. Parked cars block salting operations leaving unexpected dangerous slick spots on the pavement.

Please assist Public Works crews in restoring traffic flow and safety as soon as possible by following the parking restrictions.
