All costs and fees related to the performance of these services shall be borne by the applicant in the form of an escrow account equal to the estimated total cost of the service prior to the commencement of services including an administrative service fee of ten percent (10%) of the costs incurred by the City for such professional services or inspections. Such escrow shall be maintained throughout the course of the project and shall be returned after all costs and fees have been satisfied. This applies to those services City Staff estimates to cost \$500 or more (Ordinance 2019-23, 09-03-2019).
