Attention Genoa Residents!

There is a convenient service offered in your community for you to properly recycle or dispose of home-generated special materials. These materials should not be placed into your trash bins.

-  **Automotive Products**
Antifreeze, batteries, brake fluid, motor oil and filters, fuels and more
-  **Garden Chemicals**
Fertilizers, insect sprays, herbicides, pesticides and weed killers
-  **Paint Products**
Caulk, glue, paint, spray paint, stain, stripper, thinner and wood preservative
-  **Household Chemicals**
Ammonia, heavy-duty cleansers, shower/tile cleaner, drain cleaner, rust remover, and carpet/upholstery cleaner
-  **Electronics**
TVs, DVD/CD players, VCR, cell phones, microwaves, computers, monitors, keyboards, mouse and related cords
-  **Mercury containing devices**
Batteries, compact fluorescent lamps, thermometers, thermostats, fluorescent tubes and more



Most of the materials collected through this program are able to be sent for recycling.

How does this service work?

1. Residents can contact this service to schedule a pickup of their items.
2. A Collection Kit with instructions will be mailed to your home.
3. Read the instructions carefully, there are some items unable to be collected.
4. On day of your collection, place the Collection Bag near your front door or other area on your property that was discussed with the Customer Service Representative. The materials will be picked up at your home.
5. Materials are taken to a facility, then sorted and sent to be recycled and/or disposed of properly.
