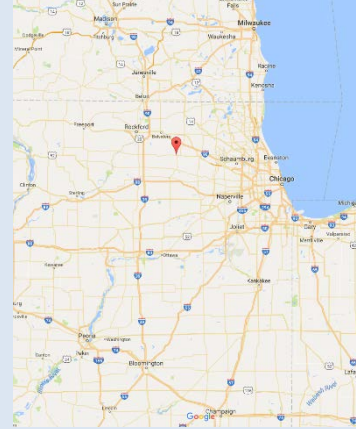


Location and Area Map

Transportation

- Access to I-90 is only 13 miles northeast of Genoa, providing direct access to Chicago and its northwest suburbs. Genoa is also a few short miles from I-39 and I-88.
- Routes 23 and 72 intersect in the City's east business district. Route 72, which passes directly through the downtown area, is a major east-west artery (Higgins Road) to the northwest suburbs.
- Genoa is served by two freight rail systems, Canadian National and Canadian Pacific. Both provide sidings for our industrial base.
- Passenger rail is currently available from METRA's Big Timber station in Elgin, 20 miles to the east.
- DeKalb's Taylor Municipal Airport is located just 17 miles to the south, providing landing for business jets, chartered flights and private aircraft.
- Rockford International Airport is just a 30 minute drive and O'Hare International Airport is 50 minutes miles to the east.



Where is Genoa?

Genoa is strategically located 60 miles west of Chicago in the rich farmland of northeastern DeKalb County. With easy access to I-90, I-88 and I-39, Genoa's location is perfect for families and businesses looking for a quiet rural community with convenient transportation to metropolitan areas. You will be close to all of the activities and conveniences of the "city" but far enough removed to enjoy the small town "good life".
