ORDINANCE NO. 2017-17

AN ORDINANCE INCREASING THE BASE HOURLY WAGE RATE FOR ALL FULL-TIME EMPLOYEES, AND FOR PART-TIME EMPLOYEES FOR THE CITY OF GENOA, COUNTY OF DEKALB, STATE OF ILLINOIS, EFFECTIVE MAY 1, 2017 AND CONTINUING THROUGH APRIL 30, 2018.

WHEREAS the City Council of the City of Genoa, Illinois has determined that it is in the best interests of the City and of City of Genoa Employees to increase base hourly wage rates from time to time:

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council as follows:


Section 1: All full-time employees other than ones covered by a collective bargaining agreement, shall receive an increase in their base hourly wage rate of approximately 3%, effective beginning with the pay period starting on May 1, 2017 and continuing through April 30, 2018.

Section 2: For part-time employees, each Department Head may revise hourly rates for part-time employees effective any pay period beginning with the pay period starting on May 1, 2017 and continuing through April 30, 2018, subject to approval of the Mayor. Increases in their base hourly wage rate may be effective any pay period beginning with the pay period starting on May 1, 2017 and continuing through April 30, 2018.

Section 3: Effective Date: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its passage by the City Council and signing and approval by the Mayor.

Passed by the City Council on the 16th day of May, 2017.
