ORDINANCE NO. 2017- 2

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF GENOA
TITLE 1, CHAPTER 4, SECTION 1

WHEREAS, The City of Genoa has heretofore adopted an ordinance relating to the fine schedule for pre-payment of ordinance citations (Title 1, Chapter 4, Section 1) and said Ordinance has thereafter been amended and is currently in full force and effect in the City of Genoa; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary from time to time to amend the City Code to remain up-to-date with changing practices and community standards; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire and intention of the Council of the City of Genoa to more adequately address the needs of the citizens of Genoa; and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the City of Genoa as follows:

SECTION 1: Title 1, Chapter 4, Section 1 fines for 5-4-6 and 5-4-7 of the City Code of Genoa shall be amended to instead read:

5-4-6	Illegal Possession of Drug Paraphernalia	\$200
5-4-7	Illegal Possession of Cannabis	\$200

SECTION 2: Title 6, Chapter 2, Section 4 subsection C be inserted to read:

C. No person may stop, park or leave standing upon a public street, highway, or roadway a vehicle upon which is displayed an Illinois registration plate or plates or registration sticker after the termination of the registration period for which the registration plate or plates or registration sticker was issued or after the expiration date set under section 3-414 of the Illinois Vehicle Code (625 ILCS 5/3-414).

SECTION 3: Title 1, Chapter 4, Section 1 fines for 6-2-4-C be inserted to read:

6-2-4-C	Vehicle parked on street with expired registration	\$20

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.


