**AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A TEMPORARY
PERMIT FOR A BEER GARDEN**

WHEREAS, Minnihan's Irish Pub would like to have a temporary beer garden in order to continue business until an amendment can be considered to the establishment's Special Use Permit;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the CITY OF GENOA, DeKalb County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: Subject to the conditions in Section 2 of this Ordinance, a temporary permit may be issued by the Mayor to a Business that holds a valid A-O liquor license in the City of Genoa described as follows:

SECTION 2: The special permit for a Beer Garden, allowing outdoor seating, on-premises sale and consumption of alcoholic liquor, is conditioned on the following:

- a. The application shall be filed at the office of the Mayor before the effective date; and
- b. The Beer Garden shall be fenced off with a minimum fence height of 6 feet with only one point of entry and exit through the principal structure of the establishment; and
- c. The Beer Garden temporary permit may extend until September 20, 2017
- d. Live or amplified music shall not be audible off the premises at decibel levels greater than normal back ground noise after 11:00 p.m. on Friday and Saturday and 10 p.m. on Sunday through Thursday; and
- e. Violations of City Ordinance shall result in shutting down the temporary Beer Garden for that evening, and if necessary, the City may revoke the temporary permit.

SECTION 3: If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, sentence or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgement shall not affect, impair, invalidate or nullify the remainder thereof, which remain and continue in full force and effect.

Section 4: All ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith and hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
