ORDINANCE NO. 2018-24

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 8, WATER AND SEWER REGULATIONS, CHAPTER 3, SECTION 13, RIGHT OF ACCESS, OF THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF GENOA

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the CITY OF GENOA, DeKalb County, Illinois, as follows:

WHEREAS, all premises using water supplied by the City are equipped with a water meter; and

WHEREAS, these said meters may require maintenance and repair over time; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department must be able to access a property to read, examine, test and repair said meters; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the Municipal Code from time to time;

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Code of the City of Genoa be amended as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title 8, Water and Sewer Regulations, Chapter 3, Section 13, Right of Access, be amended to instead read:

8-3-13: RIGHT OF ACCESS:

The Director and every person authorized by him and all meter inspectors shall have reasonable access to the premises, place or building where such meters are located for the purpose of reading, examining, testing and repairing the same, and examining and testing consumption, use and flow of water **and if reasonable access within 60 days of the date that the notification was mailed to the premise for said purpose is not provided, water service shall be discontinued**, and it shall be unlawful for any person or corporation to interfere with, prevent or obstruct said Director or such other person or inspector in his work hereunder. Every consumer of water shall take the same upon the conditions prescribed in this Title.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and following its passage and approval.
