ORDINANCE NO. 2018- 5

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY CODE OF
THE CITY OF GENOA TITLE 5, CHAPTER 2, SECTION 2**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the CITY OF GENOA, DeKalb County, Illinois, as follows:

WHEREAS, it is necessary from time to time to amend the City Code to remain up-to-date with changing practices and community standards; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire and intention of the Council of the City of Genoa to more adequately address the needs of the citizens of Genoa; and

NOW, THEREFORE, the Municipal Code of the City of Genoa be amended as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title 5, Chapter 2, Section 2, subsection A shall instead read:

5-2-2 TOBACCO PRODUCTS; SALE TO MINORS:

A. Purchase or Possession Unlawful: It shall be unlawful for any person under (18) eighteen years of age to attempt to purchase, or to possess, in a public building, place, school or park, or upon any public highway, a tobacco product, or e-cigarettes or their components, or to misrepresent their identity or age, or to use any false or altered identification for the purpose of purchasing tobacco products or e-cigarettes or their components.

SECTION 2: That Title 1, Chapter 4, Section 1 shall be amended to read:

5-2-2 A Possession of tobacco/e-cigarettes by a minor Mandatory

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and following its passage and approval.


