**ORDINANCE NO. 2019-01**  
**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING VARIOUS SECTIONS OF TITLE 4, PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY, AND TITLE 5, POLICE REGULATIONS, OF THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF GENOA**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the CITY OF GENOA, DeKalb County, Illinois, as follows:

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the Municipal Code from time to time;

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Code of the City of Genoa be amended as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title 4, Public Health and Safety, Chapter 2, Garbage, Junk, and Refuse, Section 1 be deleted and reserved.

SECTION 2: That Title 1, Administration, Chapter 4, General Penalty, Section 1, be amended by deleting:

**4-2-1 Accumulation of garbage and refuse** **\$ 50**

SECTION 3: That Title 4, Public Health and Safety, Chapter 2, Garbage, Junk, and Refuse, Section 4, subsection C 4 be amended to instead read:

4. Failure to Abate: In the event the owner or occupant where such nuisance exists has failed within the prescribed time to abate such nuisance, then the police officer, building inspector or health officer of the City who served notice, may file a complaint within the administrative adjudication system charging the owner of the property or the occupant thereof with the violation of this section.

SECTION 4: That Title 4, Public Health and Safety, Chapter 2, Garbage, Junk, and Refuse, Section D be added to read:

D. Penalty: Any person who violates this section and has been issued a citation signed by a City Law Enforcement Officer of this section shall be fined in accordance with Section 1-4-1.

SECTION 5: That Title 1, Administration, Chapter 4, General Penalty, Section 1, be amended by adding:

**4-2-4-D Storage of Junk and Refuse on Private Property** **\$ 100**

SECTION 6: That Title 4, Public Health and Safety, Chapter 2, Garbage, Junk, and Refuse, Section 6 be deleted.

SECTION 7: That the following be deleted from Title 5, Business and License Regulations, Chapter 4, Miscellaneous Offenses, Section 1 N:

2. Barking or howling dogs or cats.

3. Vehicles without mufflers or the unnecessary use of horns on vehicles. (1978 Code §42.05)

SECTION 8: That Title 5, Business and License Regulations, Chapter 3, Animal Control, Section 2 B be amended to instead read:

- B. Noisy Animals: It shall be unlawful to keep or harbor any animal which continually and unreasonably alarms or disturbs the public by loud noises. Excessive, continuous or untimely barking, molesting passersby, chasing vehicles, habitually attacking other domestic animals, trespassing upon school grounds or trespassing upon private property in such manner as to damage property, shall be deemed a nuisance.

SECTION 9: That Title 5, Business and License Regulations, Chapter 3, Animal Control, Section 2 C be added to read:

- C. Any person who violates this section and has been issued a citation signed by a City Law Enforcement Officer of this section shall be fined in accordance with Section 1-4-1.

SECTION 10: That the following be added to Title 5, Business and License Regulations, Chapter 4, Miscellaneous Offenses, Section 10:

- C. Any person who violates this section, and has been issued a citation signed by a City Law Enforcement Officer, of this section shall be fined in accordance with section 1-4-1.

SECTION 11: That the following be added Title 5, Business and License Regulations, Chapter 4, Miscellaneous Offenses, Section 11:

- C. Any person who violates this section, and has been issued a citation signed by a City Law Enforcement Officer, of this section shall be fined in accordance with section 1-4-1.

SECTION 12: That Title 1, Administration, Chapter 4, General Penalty, Section 1, be amended by adding:
