ORDINANCE NO. 2019-22 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 1, CHAPTER 4, GENERAL PENALTY, SECTION 1 AND TITLE 6, CHAPTER 1, GENERAL TRAFFIC PROVISIONS, SECTION 2 OF THE CITY CODE OF THE CITY OF GENOA

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the CITY OF GENOA, DeKalb County, Illinois, as follows:

WHEREAS, under State of Illinois Law 625 ILCS 5/12-610.2, it is now a moving violation to text while driving; and

WHEREAS, the City may not impose or receive the fines on State violations; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Code needs to reflect these changes in State Law;

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Code of the City of Genoa be amended as follows:

SECTION 1: That the following be deleted from Title 1, Chapter 4, General Penalty, Section 1:
