MINUTES

January 3, 2024 Special Meeting

Mayor and Liquor Commissioner Jonathon Brust called the special meeting of the Liquor Commission to order at 6:15 PM. On roll call, members Alderman Pam Wesner and Mayor Jonathon Brust were present; City Administrator Alyssa Seguss and Chief of Police Robert Smith were also present.

The Mayor made a motion, seconded by Alderman Wesner to approve the minutes from the October 18, 2023 Special Meeting. Upon voice vote, all members present voted aye. Minutes approved.

The Liquor Commission discussed a draft ordinance that would amend the Municipal Code to allow employees over the age of 18 to mix and serve alcohol at liquor establishments if another 21 and over employee is present. The Liquor Commission discussed some changes to said ordinance including only allowing 18+ to mix and serve alcohol at restaurants. No packaged liquor can be sold unless the employee is over 21.

The Liquor Commission also discussed recent issues at a local liquor establishment and decided that a letter needed to be sent by the Liquor Commission to the establishment to notify them of next steps should violations not be addressed.

Motion to adjourn the meeting of the Liquor Commission was made by Mayor and Liquor Commissioner Brust, seconded by Alderman Wesner. Upon voice vote, all members present voted aye. Motion carried. Meeting was adjourned at 6:50 PM.
