*An Ordinance Amending Title 3, Chapter 3, Liquor Control, of the  
Municipal Code of the City of Genoa*

WHEREAS, the Municipal Code requires amendments from time to time; and

WHEREAS, there are businesses within the community that would like to sell packaged liquor;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the CITY of GENOA, DeKalb County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That Title 3, Chapter 3, Liquor Control, Section 7 be amended as follows:

CLASS R LICENSES shall authorize the sale of beer, wine, and ale by a Restaurant or Banquet Facility for consumption in the interior portion of the premises. Class R licenses shall be restricted to the liquor districts as limited by Section 3-3-14 of this Chapter. The annual fee(s) for such license shall be as follows:

R License:	\$1,000
<b>Add on Packaged Liquor not to exceed 5 oz.</b>	<b>\$250</b>
<b>Add on Packaged Liquor</b>	<b>\$250</b>
Add on Alcoholic Liquor	\$250
Add on Outdoor Seating	\$250

SECTION 2: That Title 3, Chapter 3, Liquor Control, Section 8 be amended as follows:

E. Class R Licenses. There shall be in force at any time no more than eight (8) Class R licenses. **Of these liquor licenses, there shall be no more than one (1) "packaged liquor not to exceed 5 oz add on" issued per year and no more than one (1) "packaged liquor add on" issued per year amongst the R Liquor License holders.**

SECTION 3: If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, sentence or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair, invalidate or nullify the remainder thereof, which remainder shall remain and continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form (which publication is hereby authorized) as provided by law.
